FSA & UBBL



- Fire Services Act 1988 (Act 341)('FSA')- duties & responsibilities of the Fire & Rescue Department ('FRD'), responsibilities of the relevant persons, offences, punishments.
- Uniform Building By-Laws 1984 ('UBBL')-building construction methods & materials
- 'extinguishing, fighting, preventing, ...protecting life, property, securing the provision,... proper regulation of fire escapes...making investigation...performing humanitarian services...(section 5(1)(2) FSA

Duties of certain persons under the FSA & UBBL

- water authority to notify the FRD Director of any action affecting water flow to a fire hydrant
- -all designated premises must be issued with fire certificates
- building plan of designated premises must comply the FSA & UBBL

Discussion – Fire Hazards Issues

- FSD does not have expertise in earthquake, landslide, electricity, natural catastrophe...JKR, IKRAM, TNB, JMGS...
- Practices of architect & developer not comply with the UBBL house parting wall, wall thickness, unapproved bricks, failure to seal the boundary unit, parting wall...



- Public awareness campaign education, fire hydrant, firewall, access, MyBomba, Fire Brigade Community, periodic checking
- Not enough buffer zone
- Electrical sub-station,
 electrical line, cable cause
 women infertility
- Best practices British Standard, National Fire Protection Association (USA), Australian standard – FRD machinery, pumps, relevant tools, system
